The modern world was created on the dividend of time and wealth provided by exploiting low entropy, high energy-density fossil fuels that were very cheap compared to their use value. Such energy sources still account for most usable energy and almost all dispatchable electric power. But coal and oil use carries the penalty of emitting noxious by-products from combustion, which is a process of entropic dissipation. Therefore the top goal for the 21st century is to find ways to provide clean, cheap energy for everyone that is spontaneously adopted without political pressure. This lecture will present and explore some fundamental issues posed by this challenge.
