

Shishu-Kan Scholarship Application guidelines for AY2024

Graduate School of Advanced Integrated Studies in Human Survivability, Kyoto University (GSAIS)

1. Aims

The Shishu-kan Scholarship aims at providing students with an environment where they concentrate on their study and research activities at GSAIS without economical concerns by giving a grant to excellent students both in their studies and individuality from among the students who will be enrolled in GSAIS.

2. Type of Scholarship

- I. Shishu-kan Scholarship
- **II.** Shishu-kan Scholarship

(Financial Aid for those who are enrolled in master's course, sponsored by Mori Manufacturing Research and Technology Foundation)

3. Eligibility

Students who will be enrolled in the first year of GSAIS in April, 2024 are eligible to apply.

4. Number of Grantees

Around 10 students

(* If the number of students who fulfill the required conditions is under 10, there will be a possibility that less than 10 grantees will be selected.)

5. Scholarship Contents

100,000 yen/ per month (annually 1,200,000yen at the maximum)



You do not need to repay the scholarship. It is prohibited to apply for other scholarship while you are the grantee of the Shishu-Kan scholarship.

6. Scholarship Period

For two years after the enrollment in the first year of GSAIS

7. Selection

Grantees will be selected by making a general judgment based on the results of the entrance examination and application documents.

(Those who become candidates for Shishu-kan Scholarship Type II are also required to pass the selection of Mori Manufacturing Research and Technology Foundation.)

8. Selection Results

Selection results will be notified to the applicants in early March, 2024.

9. Application Procedures (Common in Type I \cdot II)

Those who wish to apply for the Shishu-kan Scholarship should submit the application form and required documents to our office either by mail or in person before the deadline below. The application form and required documents will be sent to those who have passed the entrance examination.

Please note that you cannot choose which to apply, type I or II of the scholarship.

Submission: Kyomu (Student affairs section) of GSAIS

Deadline: November 17 (Fri.) 2023, by 5PM

Those who pass the entrance examination in winter with excellence will be also eligible to apply for the scholarship. Please check upcoming information for the application in winter.
